

INVITATION TO BID

Gallatin County is requesting sealed bids for drilling services at the Gallatin County Logan Landfill to be received by Gallatin County Clerk and Recorder's office at 311 West Main, Room #203, Bozeman, MT 59715 until 4:00 p.m. local time on March 16, 2026. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Clerk and Recorder's Office, 311 W. Main, Bozeman, MT 59715 at 4:00 p.m. on March 16, 2026.

The project consists of drilling and installing twelve (12) new gas monitoring probes and one exempt non-potable water supply well at the Gallatin County Logan Landfill. Additional information and scope of work is provided in Exhibit A of the drilling solicitation and specifications.

There will be a Pre-Bid meeting and project site tour at the Logan Landfill office at 10585 Two Dog Road, Three Forks, MT 59752 on February 19, 2026, at 10:00 AM. Interested contractors are encouraged to attend.

Contractor and any of the Contractor's Subcontractors bidding or doing work on this project will be required to be registered with the Montana Department of Labor and Industry (DLI). Forms for registration are available from the Department of Labor and Industry. All laborers and mechanics employed by Contractor or Subcontractors in performance of the construction work shall be paid wages at rates as required by Montana Prevailing Wage Rates. The Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex or national origin.

Each bid or proposal must be accompanied by a Certified Check, Cashier's Check, or Bid Bond payable to Gallatin County, in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid. Successful Bidders shall furnish an approved Performance Bond and a Labor and Materials Payment Bond, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount. Insurance, as required, shall be provided by the successful Bidder(s) and a certificate(s) of that insurance shall be provided. This solicitation shall not commit Owner to enter into any agreement, or pay any expenses related to the preparation of any bids.

The right is reserved to reject any or all proposals received, to waive informalities, to postpone the award of the contract for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days, and to accept the lowest responsive and responsible bid that is in the best interest of the Owner.

All questions about the meaning or intent of the Contract Documents are to be submitted in writing and must be received by Gallatin County no later than 5:00 p.m. local time on March 6, 2026. Questions received after this date will not be answered. Interpretations or clarifications considered necessary in response to such questions will be issued by Addenda delivered to all parties recorded as having received the Bidding Documents. Only questions answered by Addenda will be binding. Oral and other interpretations or clarifications will be without legal effect.
